2024 Mile Lane Disc Golf Players Guide

- COST:** \$35 entrance fee or \$30 with a Mile Lane Disc Golf Course Tag
- PLAYERS PACK:** Every player receives two new MVP discs
- PRIZES:** Prizes for general champion, second place and third place, plus for mixed division champion and runners-up will be discs
- FIELD SIZE:** Because of the size of course and flow of play, tournament will be limited to 15 teams
- FORMAT:** Two rounds of 24-holes (Holes 1 to 12 short and 1 to 12 long)
- DIVISIONS:** Two divisions—General and Mixed (Include at least one female or youth)
- CHAMPIONSHIP:** Top three teams (any division) play a six hole championship round
- SCORING:** UDisc will be used this year. Paper scorecards will be available as a back up, sheets indicating starting hole rotation will be provided to all players. Participants should sign up to uDisc event before event.



Tournament Details

- Morning Round of Doubles tournament will be alternative-throw format (except same player can only drive twice in a row) - Teams select their person to drive each hole and then alternate shot until putt is made.
- Afternoon Round of Doubles tournament will be best throw format (except same player can only drive twice in a row)
- Final Six Holes for the Top Three Teams (from any division or any additional teams tied for third place) will be best throw format (except same player can only drive twice in a row)
- Both Morning and Afternoon rounds will follow league format— Holes 1—12 Short and then 1-12 Long (24 holes each round) - Championship round will feature Long Holes 13—18
- All six baskets may have players — When going counter clockwise (1-6) holes 2, 4, 5, 6 (short) and holes 2, 5, 6 (long) can throw first and other holes will follow. Clockwise (7-12) holes 7, 8, 11, 12 (short) and hole 11 (long) can throw first and other holes will follow. Holes 7, 8 and 12 can drive if card in front is watching

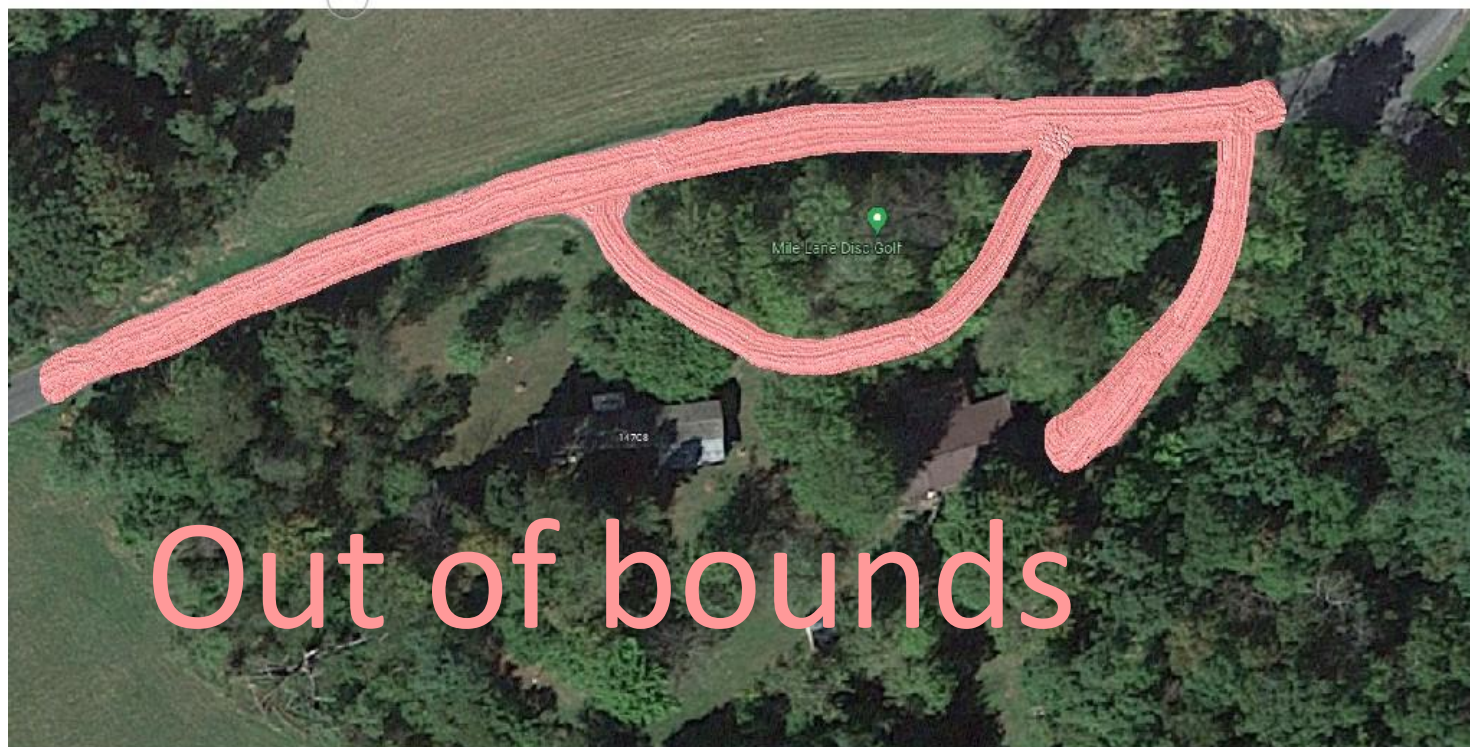
Other Details

- Restrooms will be available
- Water will be available
- Youth Teams with both players under 15 or female will be allowed to play short tees both times. **All other teams—including Mixed—must have both partners drive from long tees on second 12 holes of both round.**
- Parking—Parking is available at the top of the far driveway, in the grass area past that driveway next to Mile Lane and at the bottom right of our neighbors driveway.



PACE OF PLAY

- Because Mile Lane Disc Golf is built on a very small piece of property and incorporates six baskets there are some inherent challenge in bringing a large group for a league or a tournament. We have done our best to accommodate this size of a group to the best of our abilities.
- The six baskets are designated by colors: Black, Red, Orange, Yellow, Green and Blue. First six holes go in a counter-clockwise pattern, next six holes reverse and go in a clock-wise pattern. The championship six holes are random.
- We will attempt to place at least one team that is familiar with the layout on each card to help direct the flow of the course.
- **NEW FOR 2024**—The road (Mile Lane) and both driveways, play as out of bounds. This could affect holes 1, 6, 7, 11, 12 and playoff hole 14. Discs that are completely touching road or driveway are considered Out of Bounds, one stroke penalty assessed and lie is established one-meter from where disc was last in bounds. Discs that are partially on road or drive way but touching grass/dirt are considered in bounds and player can move their lie 1 meter away from the out of bounds.



- Other objects—porch, vehicles, stream, bushes, etc. are all casual. If the disc is playable where it lies, it should be played from that spot. If relief is needed (brush piles, sticker bushes), that will be appropriate and behind the point where the disc entered.

- Discs cannot be thrown over either house. Hole 17 (Final 3 Playoffs) must go to the back of the both homes. Any shot that goes over a house will be played at the closest corner it crossed over the home.
- There is very little traffic on Mile Lane, but if vehicles are coming, your disc should be moved until they pass.
- **NEW FOR 2024**—Hole three and hole nine will both play as an “island” hole. First shot must land inside the 24’ circle around the basket. If the first shot does not land in the circle there is a drop zone to the left at the base of the hill (Hole 3) or tee-pad for long 10 (Hole 9) and a one-stroke penalty. The shot from the drop zone does not need to land in the circle.
- On hole 16 (Final 3 playoff), the Locust Tree at the base of the hill/orange basket green will be a MANDO left. You will need to MANDO left around the locust tree and head to the lower driveway. If you pass the mando tree to the right you through from the drop zone – one meter from mando tree – and receive a one stroke penalty
- Safety First—Never throw when other players or people are within range. Always give non-players the right of way. Be aware of your surroundings and environment.
- Courtesy is huge in disc golf. Players must not display unsportsmanlike behavior, such as cursing, shouting, striking/kicking the course or equipment, distracting others, littering, or interfering with other players in any way.
- Players should help to find lost discs, keep score correctly, and help to move equipment if and when asked. Please help spot for all
- Best lie should be marked with mini or played behind the shot.
- Hole must be finished by disc coming to lie in basket cage or in chains.
- HOLE ROTATION (12 short and 12 long) Please be aware of starting hole and rotation when filling out scores.

Doubles:

Morning Round—Alternate Shot

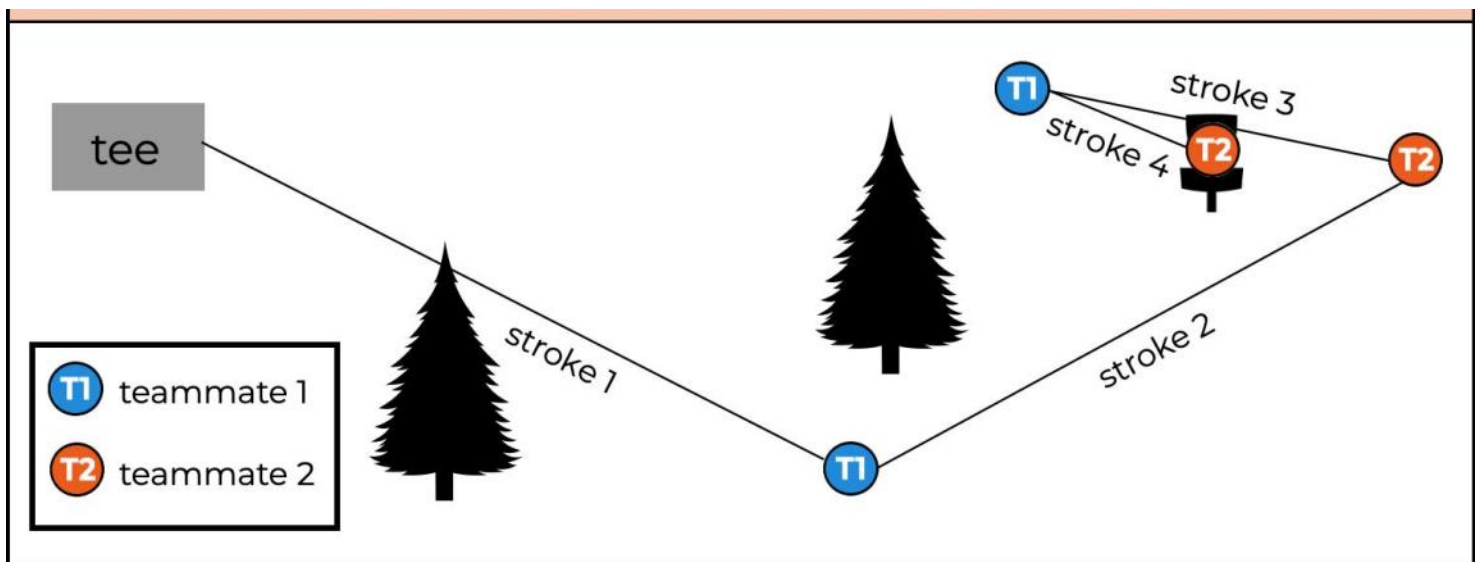
One partner drives from the tee. (one stroke)

Second partner then takes next throw from new lie. (one stroke)

Rotation continue until a teammate player putts into the basket the hole is finished for that team.

A team may only use one players drives twice in a row. After that the other player only drives

You are not required to keep any order when it comes to you and your partner determining who will throw first for each hole.



Please note—there will be backups because of the size of the course and large field. Please prepare accordingly. Thank you!

Doubles:

Afternoon Round & Championship Round—Best Shot

Both partners drive from the tee. (one stroke)

Each team picks the best lie from their throws and mark it.

Each player then takes next throw from new lie. (one stroke)

Again the best lie is marked. Repeat towards basket. (Stroke for each lie)

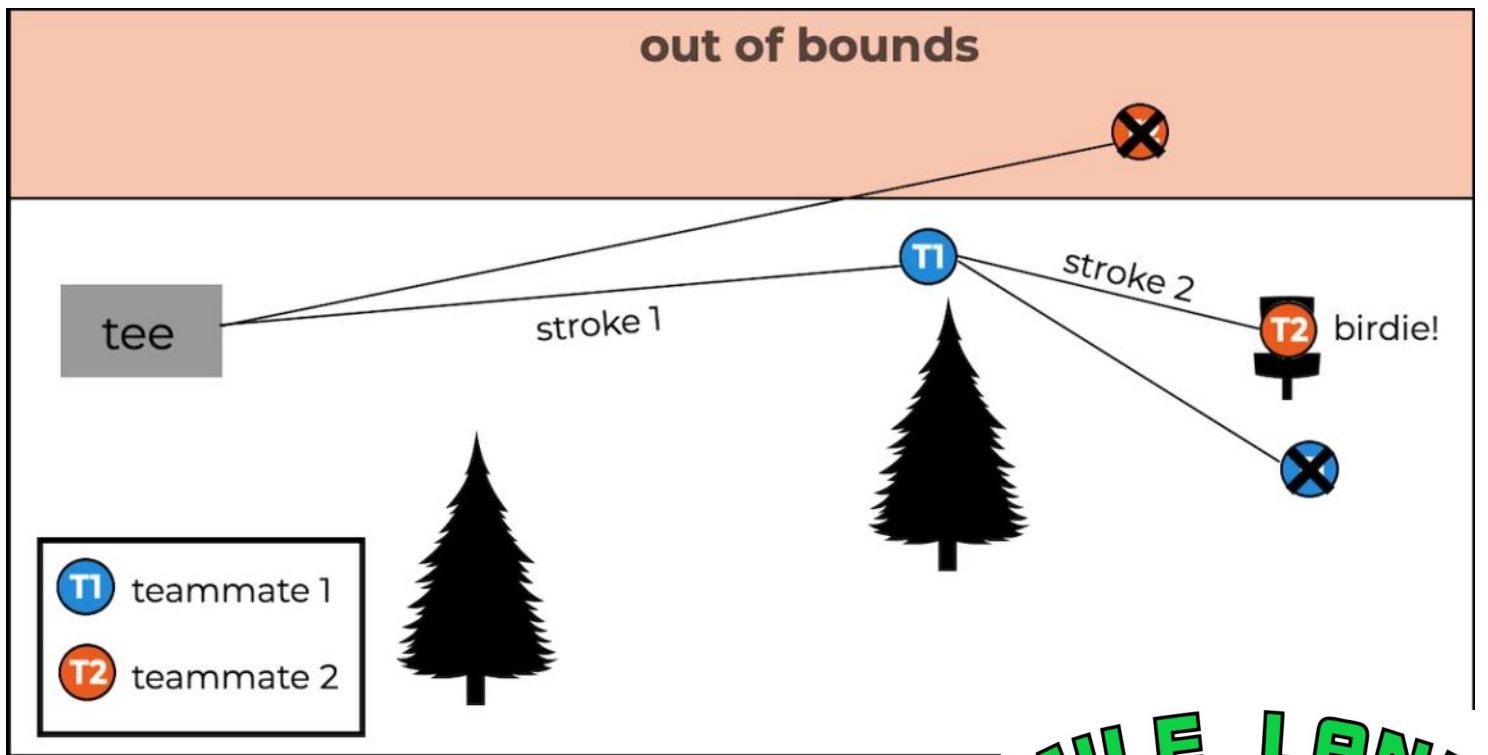
When the final lie marks a putt both players attempt the putt. (one stroke)

Only one player is required to make the putt in.

When a player putts into the basket the hole is finished for that team.

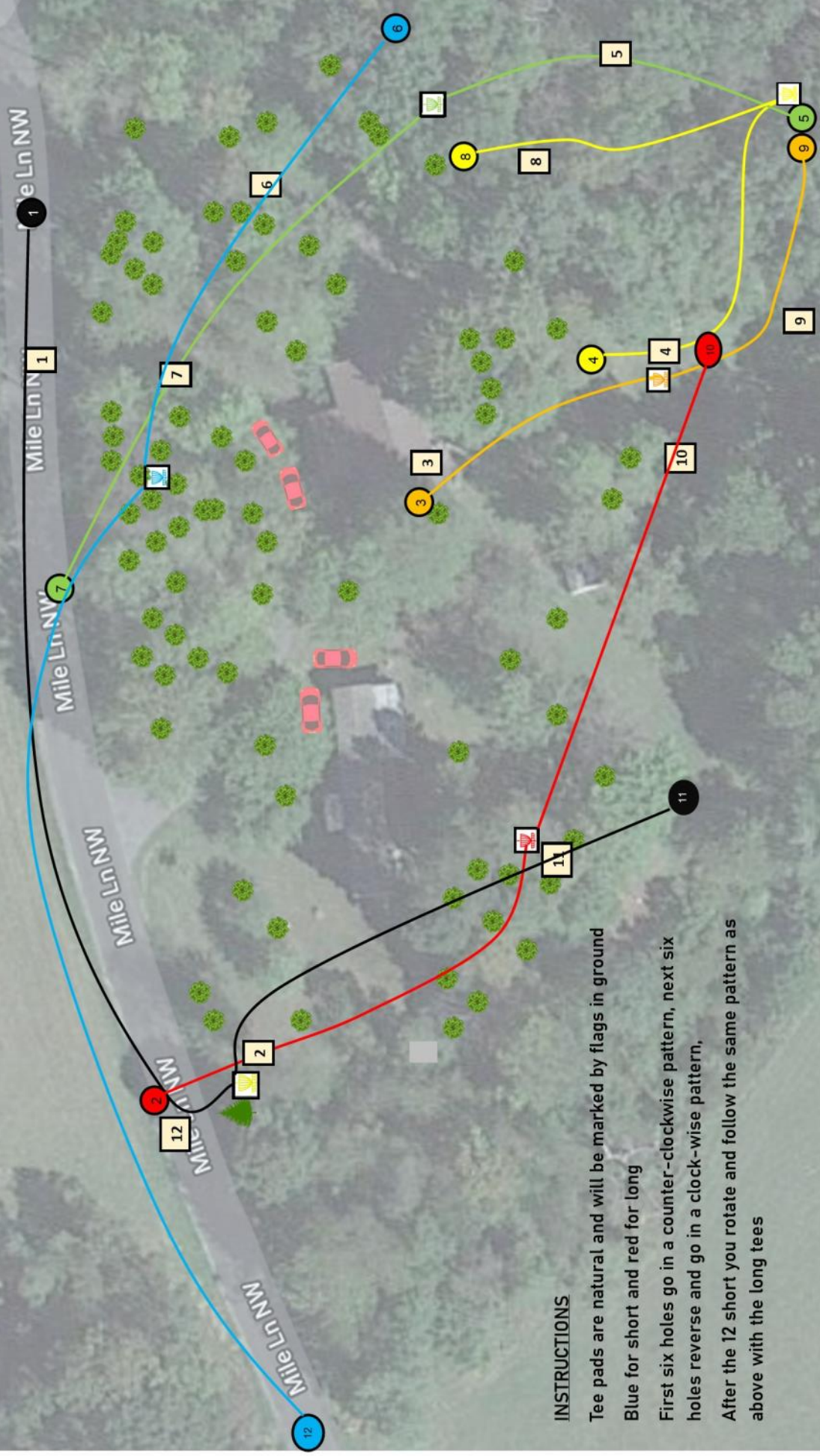
A team may only use one player's drives twice in a row. After that the other player only drives.

You are not required to keep any order when it comes to you and your partner determining who will throw first for each hole.

Tournament Layout

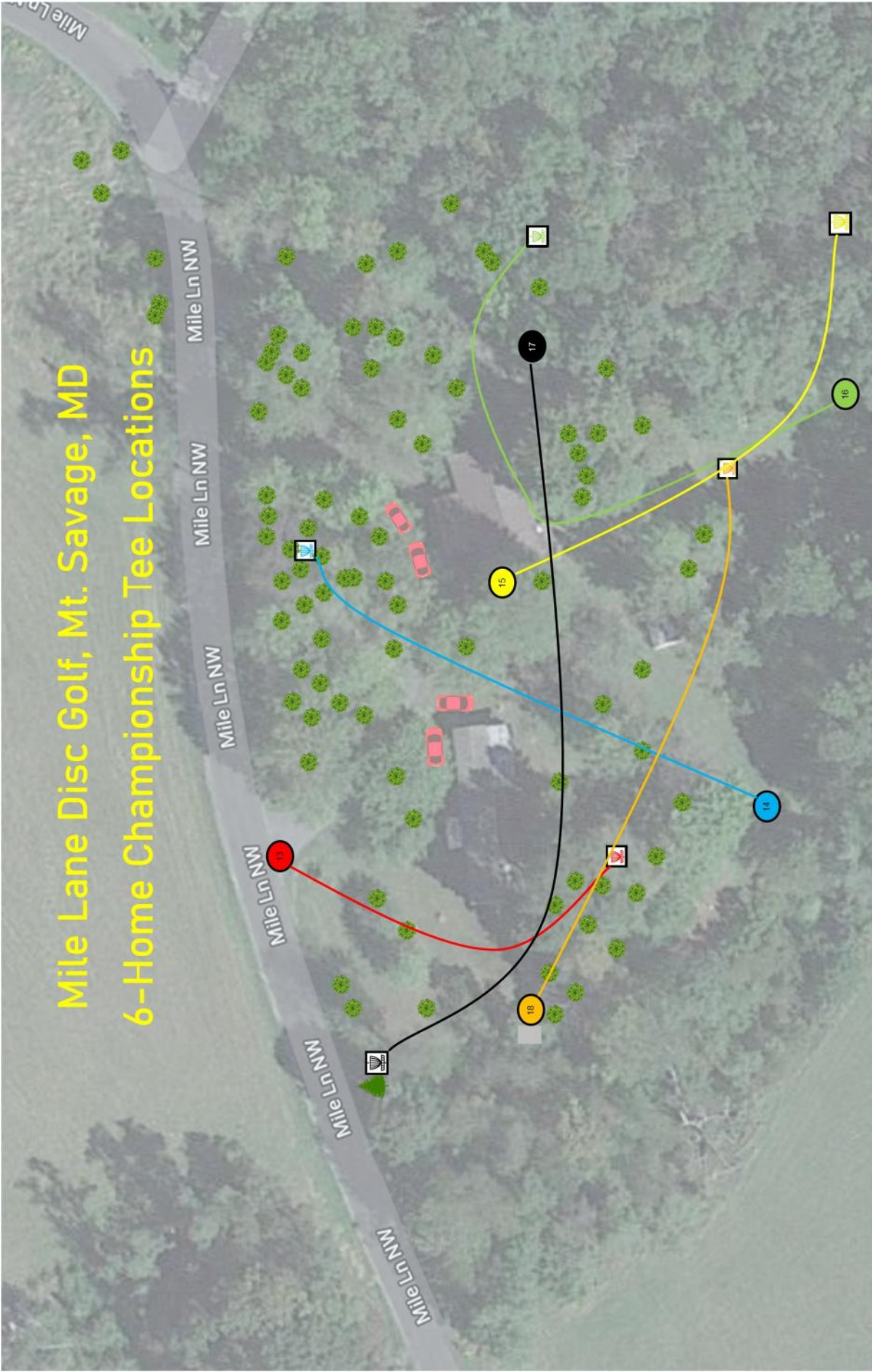


INSTRUCTIONS

- Tee pads are natural and will be marked by flags in ground
- Blue for short and red for long
- First six holes go in a counter-clockwise pattern, next six holes reverse and go in a clock-wise pattern,
- After the 12 short you rotate and follow the same pattern as above with the long tees
