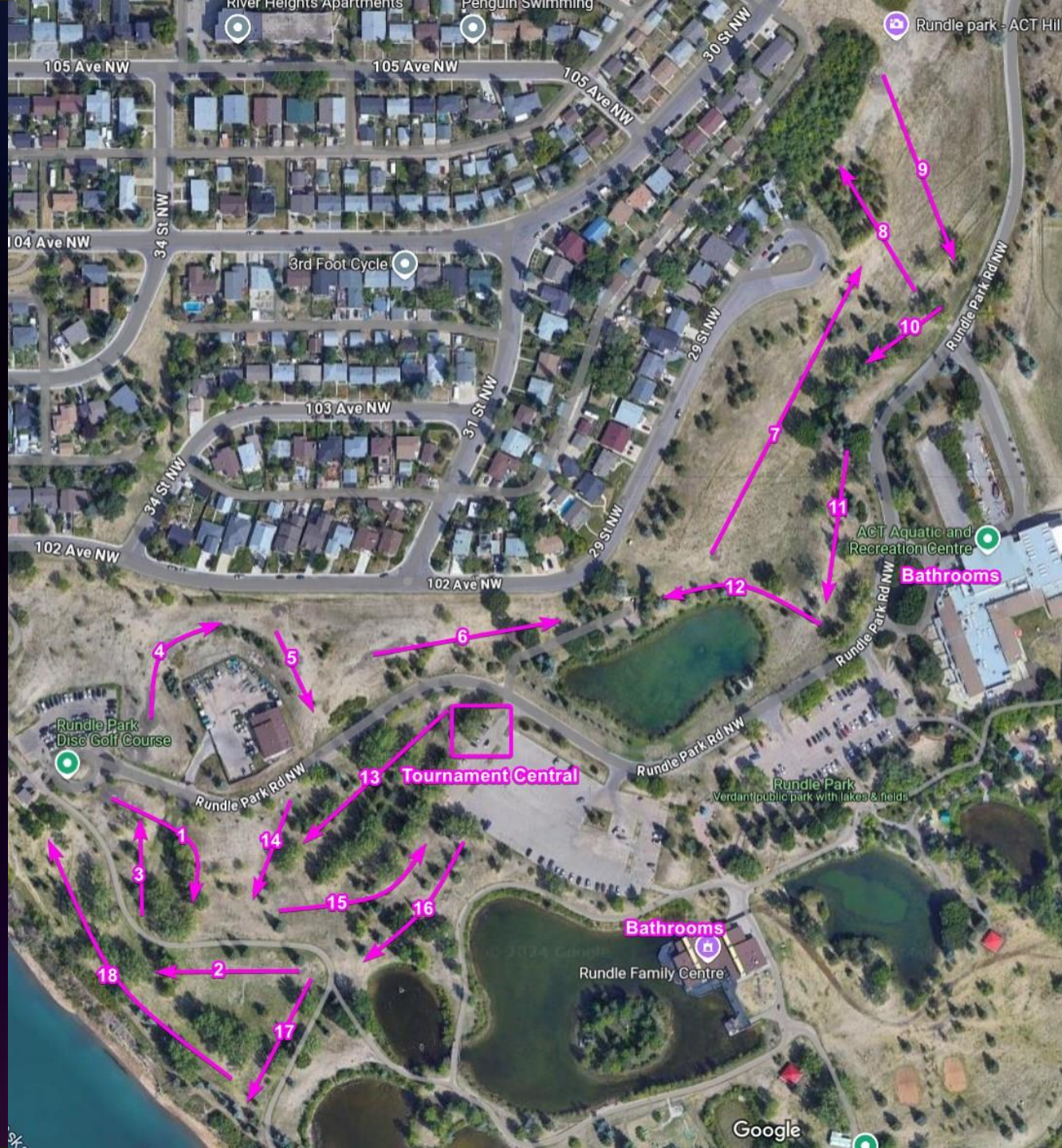
RULES
